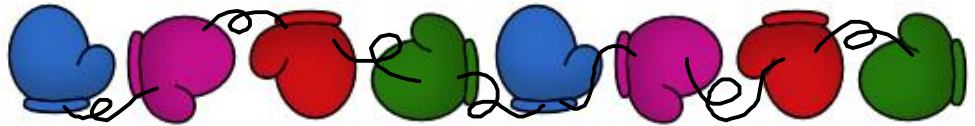

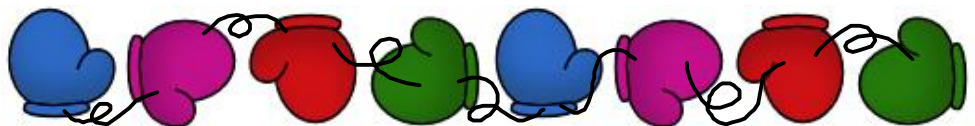


## Reminders

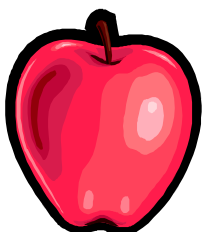

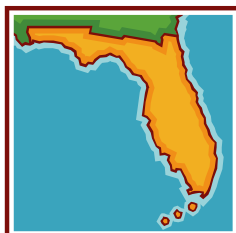

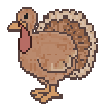
