We will learn about Johnny Appleseed and how he planted apple orchards and some of these trees still grow apples today.

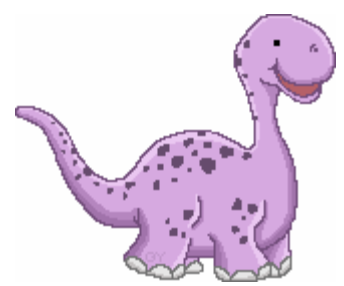
Dinosaurs

Sweet & Sour Pork Meatballs



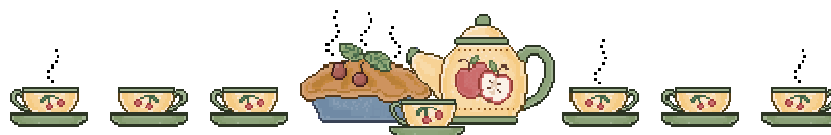
Meatballs

1 lb ground pork or beef
2 cups breadcrumbs
1 cup milk
2 eggs beaten
1 tsp salt

Sauce

1 ½ cups brown sugar
½ cup vinegar
1 cup water
1 TBSP dried mustard

Mix pork, bread crumbs, milk, eggs & salt. Make 24 small meatballs. Place into a baking dish 9X13". Prepare sauce by mixing brown sugar, vinegar, water and dried mustard. Pour over meatballs and bake at 325 degrees for 40 minutes. Serve over rice.

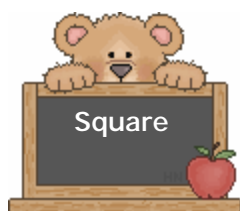
