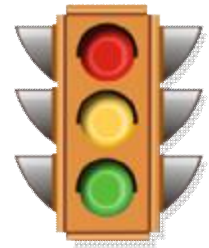

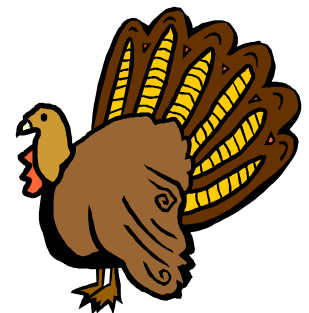
Counting Down To Thanksgiving

Recipes



Yummy Banana Bread

1 cup mashed ripe bananas (about 2 medium)

3/4 cup sugar or Splenda

1/4 cup canola oil

2 large eggs

1 3/4 cups flour

1 1/4 tsp cream of tartar

3/4 tsp baking soda

1/2 tsp salt

Mixture of cinnamon and sugar (optional)

Preheat oven to 350 degrees

Combine the first 4 ingredients in a large bowl; beat with a mixer at medium speed until smooth.

Combine flour, cream of tartar, baking soda and salt in a bowl, stirring with a whisk.

Add flour mixture to banana mixture, stirring until moist.

Spray an 8X4 inch loaf pan coated with cooking spray.

Sprinkle cinnamon and sugar mixture in loaf pan to coat the sides and bottom.

Spoon batter into loaf pan and bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes.

Test bread by inserting a toothpick. If it comes out clean, the bread is baked through. May require additional bake time.

When done, cool 10 minutes on a wire rack; remove from pan. Cool completely on rack

Butter and enjoy!!!

To freeze, wrap tightly in plastic wrap and place in a freezer plastic bag. Good for up to a month.

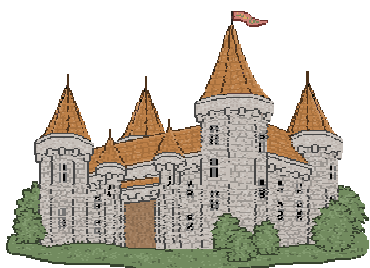
