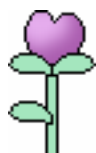

Breakfast Recipes



French Toast Waffles

1 beaten egg

¼ cup milk

2 TBSP melted butter

1/8 tsp salt

sliced bread

Combine the egg, milk butter and salt. Coat the sliced bread with the batter and cook on a waffle iron.



French Toast

4 eggs beaten lightly

½ tsp salt

1 cup milk

½ tsp vanilla

sugar & cinnamon mixture

sliced bread

Mix the eggs, salt, milk and vanilla together.

Brown the bread on both sides on a well buttered hot griddle. Sprinkle with sugar & cinnamon



Traditional Skillet Hoe Cakes

1 pkg. corn muffin mix

¾ cup milk

1 egg

Spray cold cast iron pan with cooking spray and heat over medium high heat. Sprinkle a bit of water and it should dance. Turn heat down to medium low (3 ½ to 4)

Mix the muffin mix, milk and egg together. Pour enough batter into the pan to form a pancake but leave enough room around the edges to easily flip. Only cook until it is lightly brown and then flip.
