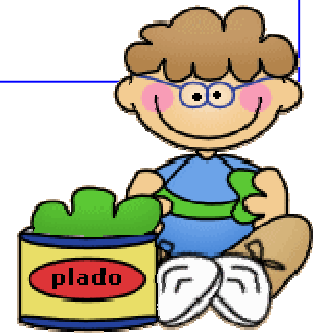

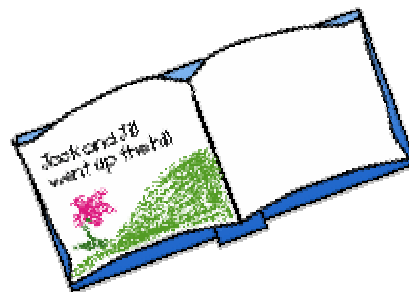
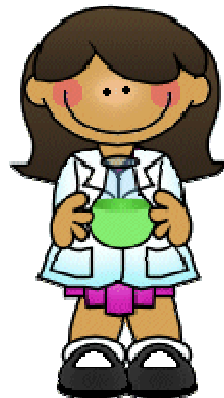

September Recipe

8-10 slices of dry bread (heals of the loaves work great)
1/4 cup butter or margarine melted
1 cup brown sugar packed
1 tsp cinnamon



Melt butter

Break bread up, set aside

Combine brown sugar, cinnamon, allspice & reserve 3 TBSP for topping

Pour melted butter on bread crumbs and toss with sugar mixture

Place bread mixture in a baking dish that has been sprayed with non-stick cooking spray.

Combine eggs, salt & vanilla in a bowl & beat for 1 minute, then add milk slowly

Pour over bread mixture and let stand for 5 minutes

Sprinkle on reserved sugar mixture on top and bake at 325 degrees for 45-50 minutes.
Serve with dream whip, cool whip or a spoonful of vanilla ice cream

Bread Pudding

3 eggs
1/4 tsp salt
1 tsp vanilla
3 cups milk scald and cooled
Dream whip, Cool Whip or vanilla ice cream
